Much of the nation will be experiencing a significant freeze event In the coming days. With this In mind, we are reaching out to recommend the following basic preventive measures to protect church property from loss.

- 1. Open cabinets and let faucets drip to prevent pipes from freezing and bursting. If your building will be unoccupied for a period of time, consider turning off the water and draining your pipes to decrease the risk of freezing.
- 2. Drain outside faucets. Remove garden hoses from outside faucets; if possible, turn off the water and drain the faucets.
- 3. Designate someone to walk through the buildings daily to verify the heat is on so you can spot any issues as soon as they occur.
- 4. Take special care with space heaters. Keep them at least 3 feet away from flammable materials. Leave them on the floor. Never leave them running unattended. Unplug when not using, and never use them on the same circuit as other high-wattage electronics.
